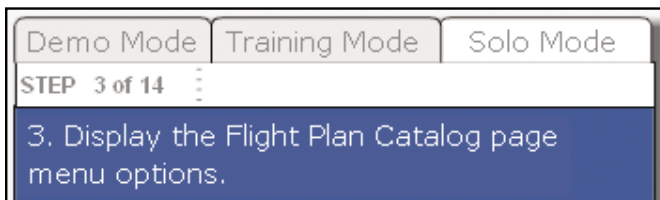

Users can move between Modes by clicking on any of the three tabs at any time. A counter informs them as to which step they're on and how many steps there are in the selected mode.

1. Demo Mode

An animated, narrated sequence demonstrates the selected task.

2. Training Mode


The user practices the operation just demonstrated, assisted with on-screen “pop-up” prompts that guide the user through the task.
